OUR **PRIMARY RESEARCH QUESTION** IS: HOW CAN INTERGENERATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS CONTRIBUTE TO, CHALLENGE, AND TRANSCEND BARRIERS TO REALIZING CHILD RIGHTS?

WHERE?

WHY?

OUR GOAL IS TO GROW **INTERGENERATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS** TO ADVANCE CHILD RIGHTS IN RESEARCH, POLICIES, AND PRACTICE. WE WILL CREATE RESEARCH RESULTS SUCH AS PUBLICATIONS, PRESENTATIONS AND WEBINARS. WE ARE RESEARCHING HOW INTERGENERATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS (WHERE ADULTS AND YOUNG PEOPLE WORK TOGETHER) CAN HELP REALIZE CHILDREN'S RIGHTS.

HOW?

- **INTERGENERATIONAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE (IAC)**
IAC MEMBERS AUGMENT ICCRP EXPERTISE, PERSPECTIVES, & BEST PRACTICES FOR INTERGENERATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS. THE IAC IS MADE UP OF **8 ADULTS & 14 YOUNG PEOPLE** FROM AROUND THE WORLD, TO ADVISE THE PARTNERSHIP. THE IAC YOUNG PEOPLE WILL BE RECRUITED FOLLOWING ALL ETHICS APPROVALS.
- **STEERING COMMITTEE (SC)**
THE SC IS THE ICCRP'S PRIMARY DECISION-MAKING BODY WHERE ALL KEY INFORMATION RELATED TO RESEARCH STREAMS, WORKING GROUPS, & ADVISORY COMMITTEES IS RECEIVED AND COMMUNICATED ACROSS THE PROJECT.
- **11 CASE STUDIES FROM AROUND THE WORLD (CSS)**
CASE STUDY RESEARCH IS LED BY INTERNATIONAL CO-APPLICANTS (COAS) & COLLABORATORS (COLS).
- **4 WORKING GROUPS (WGS) CONTACT THE ICCRP IF INTERESTED IN JOINING**
OUR FOUR WGS ARE INTEGRAL TO THE RESEARCH PROCESSES IN ALL RSS, AS KEY VEHICLES FOR SYNTHESIS OF CASE-STUDY DATA AND INCISIVE APPLICATION OF OUR THEORETICAL APPROACH OF RELATIONAL CHILD RIGHTS
- **PARTNERS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (PAC) CONTACT THE ICCRP IF INTERESTED IN JOINING**
THE PAC WORKS CLOSELY WITH THE SC TO ADVISE ON RESEARCH DIRECTIONS TO ENSURE THAT THE ICCRP MAINTAINS ITS FOCUS ON RESEARCH, POLICY, AND PRACTICE AND REMAINS RESPONSIVE TO PARTNER CONTEXTS AND PRIORITIES.
- **KNOWLEDGE MOBILIZATION COMMITTEE (KMBC) CONTACT THE ICCRP IF INTERESTED IN JOINING**
THE KMBC INCLUDES TEAM MEMBERS WITH EXTENSIVE RELEVANT EXPERTISE & ACCESS TO STAKEHOLDER NETWORKS, WHO FACILITATE MULTIDIRECTIONAL, NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL FLOW OF KNOWLEDGE ACROSS ACADEMIA & SOCIETY.
